I am pleased to report that the parish is restoring its relationship with the local conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SSVP). Driven by love and justice, SSVP helps local communities with compassion: learn more at www.ssvp.ca. The conference also includes Holy Cross Parish and St. Peter's Parish. Gene volunteers at the Chez Vincent store at 1650 Queensdale Avenue, and Geraldo is our representative to the conference.

As our contribution to the conference, we will host an SSVP Clothing Sale from Thursday, 11 June through Saturday, 13 June. The sale is intended for people from the the whole region including the territories of Holy Cross and St. Peter's; and shoppers from Our Lady of the Visitation are welcome too. The sale will feature carefully inspected and vetted clothing from SSVP stores, so we are NOT seeking more donated clothing for the sale. Their volunteers will set up, run and take down the event, but volunteers from the regional parishes (including ours) are welcome to join them.

There is a special collection this weekend for the Pastoral Works of the Holy Father. Also known as the "Peter's Pence" collection, the Pope uses these funds to provide immediate aid to victims of war, famine and natural disasters, and to support marginalized communities worldwide. The funds are also used to support the administration of the Holy See.
