PASTOR'S MESSAGE

I was with 33 Brigade at CFB Petawawa on Ex WOLFPACK GUARDIAN from 21-29 August. I said Mass for the soldiers and helped some in distress.

Working with the Brigade Chaplain, we built on last year's success and strengthened the foundation for next year. We were very pleased to have been given a tent that served as the Multi Faith Space, with opportunity for Muslims, Indigenous and others to pray as well.

The Quarterly Financial Report for Q2 (April-June 2026) is now available, and copies are available in the vestibule and on the website. Our Taxable Revenue and Non-Taxable Revenue are higher than projected, but Extraordinary Revenues to pay off the loan for the rectory roofs is lower than planned. Diocesan Tax is less than planned because of rebates from overpayments from 2024 and 2025: thanks to George, Colleen and the Archdiocese for identifying these. Maintenance is higher than budgeted, at least partially from rectory upgrades paid by the pastor.

Thanks to a parishioner for a significant donation to pay off the new rectory furnace.

The main entrance of the church will be unlocked during office hours to allow private prayer.

We are pleased to announce that six new seminarians have begun formation: Dn. David Mulclair, Jean Charles Beaulieu, Alain Bercier, Jeremy Crowe, Paschal Ezenwaka, and Pablo Leiva; but Paschal Fontillas has withdrawn from formation.
